Recycle these items

Standard Recyclables at All Locations

- Cardboard – packing boxes, cereal and dry food boxes, flattened
- Newspaper and glossy inserts
- Mail, catalogs and magazines
- Office and copy paper
- Telephone books
- Aluminum cans, foil and steel cans
- Narrow neck plastic bottles with a 1 or 2, such as plastic soda and water bottles, milk and juice jugs, and shampoo and detergent bottles, no lids or caps
- Glass jars and bottles of any color, no lids or caps

Specialty Recyclables at Charles City Road and Springfield Road Sites ONLY

- Antifreeze, oil and oil filters
- Appliances and scrap metals (Freon removal fees apply)
- Batteries – rechargeable and lead acid
- Goodwill Donations (at Charles City Road only)
- Paints
- Propane tanks
- Tires (fees apply)
- Too Good to Waste
- Yard Waste



Other items like electronics can be recycled at different locations.
